\$22,940

This funding will be used to

- Ensure Prep to Year 2 students achieve 80% or higher on the Mt Isa Oral Language Post test assessment tool.
- Maintain or increase 90% (Semester 2, 2018) of students achieving a C in English.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a B in English or higher from 25% (Semester 2, 2018) to 35%.
- Ensure that every child with an Individual Curriculum Plan achieves a C standard or better against the relevant year level achievement standard in English and Maths.

Our initiatives include

- Refine and embed the whole school approach to teaching writing.
- Use Early Start materials in Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing.
- Implement, refine and embed a context specific, evidence based oral language program for students in the Early Years.
- Use of the literacy continuum with a focus on monitoring writing development.
- Develop teacher data literacy to effectively inform teaching and learning.
- Implementing a pre-school learning program based on the Early Years Childhood Framework (EYCF)
 "Playsteps" through our playgroup to promote a smooth transition to the Prep program.

Engaging teacher aide to support small focus groups and targeted intervention in English.	\$6000

Provision of Professional Development (PD) in writing, specifically giving targeted feedback, to all teachers and teacher aides.	\$2200
Provision of release time for teachers to attend pre and post assessment moderation with cluster schools.	\$2000
Release teachers for 5 weekly progress meetings to analyse student data and review and set targets.	\$2000
Use of online programs to support literacy development.	\$2000
Provision of opportunities for teachers to collaborate with cluster teachers with the aim of sharing practice.	
Upskilling of teaching staff in the use of the Literacy Continuum and the One School dashboard.	
Purchase of teacher resources to support the whole school writing approach.	\$240
